Brown pelicans late to migrate due to warmer winters, can be at risk of tissue damaging frost bite and starvation.

These pelicans benefit from monitoring or rescue if frostbite has already occurred.

The pelicans are transported to pelican rehabbers, who provide treatment for frostbite based on severity and food to address poor body conditions.
